POSSESSIVE DETERMINERS

(Determinantes possessivos)

Personal pronouns	Possessive determiners
I	My
You	Your
He	His
She	Her
It	Its
We	Our
You	Your
They	Their

I'm Bart Simpson.
My favourite hobby is skateboarding.
(Eu sou o Bart Simpson.
O meu passatempo preferido é andar de skate.)



Singular

my (meu, minha, meus, minhas)
your (teu, tua, teus, tuas)
his / her / its (seu, sua, seus, suas)

Plural

our (nosso, nossa, nossos, nossas)
your (vosso, vossa, vossos, vossas)
their (seu, sua, seus, suas)

Nota: O determinante possessivo **his** utiliza-se quando o possuidor é do género masculino e **her** quando é do género feminino.
